If your physician does not prescribe "Dispense as Written", and there is a generic alternative for the prescription drug, and you choose a brand instead, you will pay the difference in cost between the generic and brand name medication plus the applicable brand copayment amount.

If your physician prescribes a brand name drug and communicates on the prescription "Dispense as Written" (DAW), you will pay the brand name copayment only.

### **Mail Order Service**

The Mail Order Service allows you to receive a 90-day supply of maintenance medications. This program is part of your pharmacy benefit and is **voluntary**.

Costco Specialty Services helps members who are taking medications for certain chronic illnesses or complex diseases by providing services that offer convenience and support. This program is part of your pharmacy benefit and is **voluntary**.
